## Key Takeaways

- AI Artificial Intelligence, especially General Artificial Intelligence (GenAI), was a topic in most all sessions. Leverage it with caution and oversight
- Exposure Management Going beyond the traditional security methods and ensuring you cover all bases in a continuous fashion, including social, API's, dark web, IoT, mobile and more
- Tool Consolidation "Best of Breed" point solutions were once the recommendation. Today organizations should leverage the platform for easier administration (especially given the significant talent shortages), lower cost and for similar feature parity
- Identity Treat as Critical Infrastructure, the core of Zero Trust and the heart of Data Security and Privacy through Access Controls
- Data Security Data is the root of all concerns. By decoupling the data from applications, organizations will find better ways to ensure better security and privacy especially for regulatory compliance
- Application Security Especially with AI and API's, a big shift is occurring and if you want to keep up you need to start evaluating your development pipeline
- Security Posture Management (xSPM) For most areas within Cybersecurity, you will likely find a SPM for the space; weather Cloud, Identity, Application, Data, API, AI, and more to continuously evaluate the overall posture in near real-time to ensure your defenses and responses are performing optimally
- Security Behavior and Culture Programs (SBCP) the modern method to secure the human factor within your organization since Security Awareness Training hasn't provided the anticipated results
